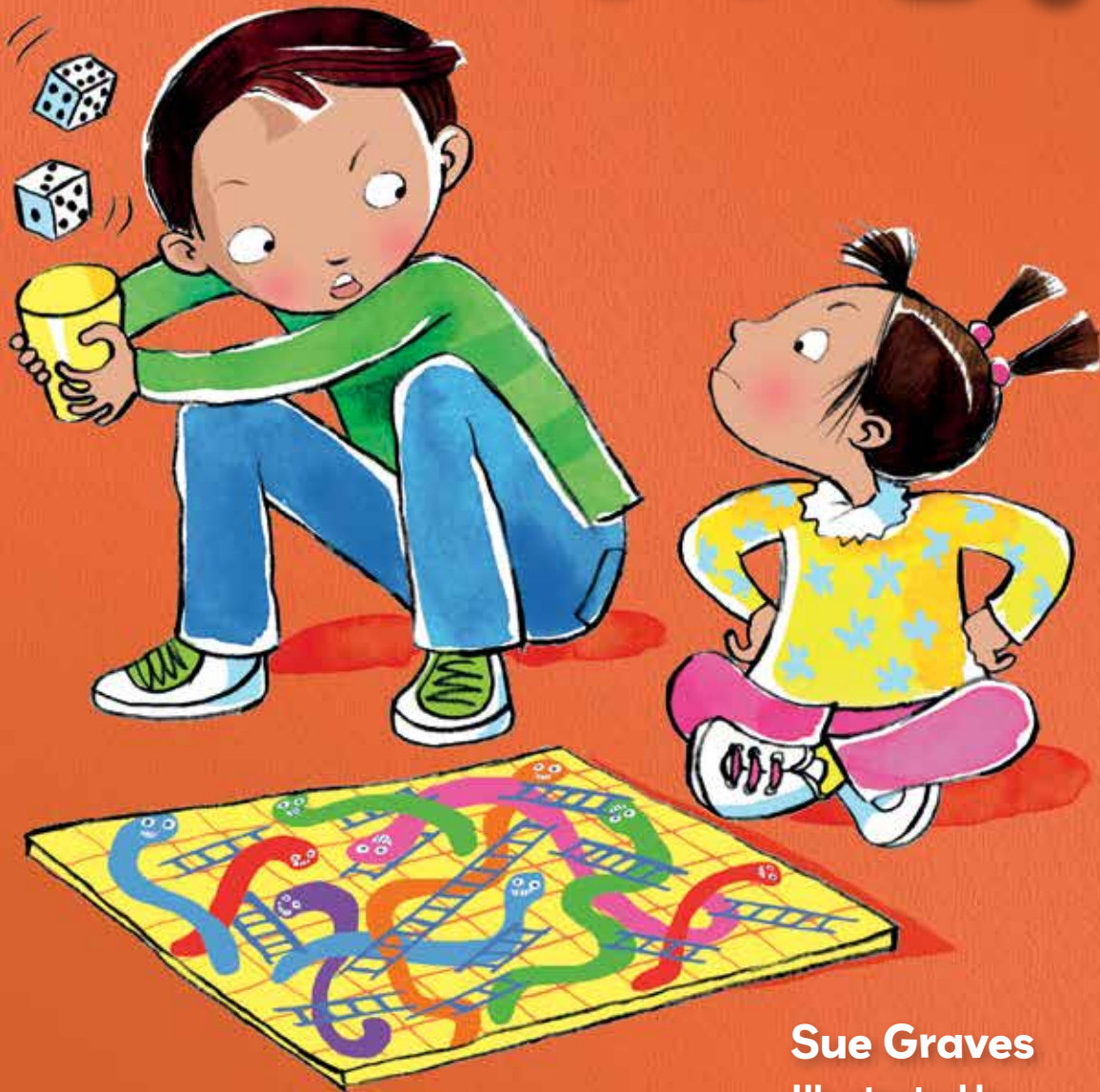

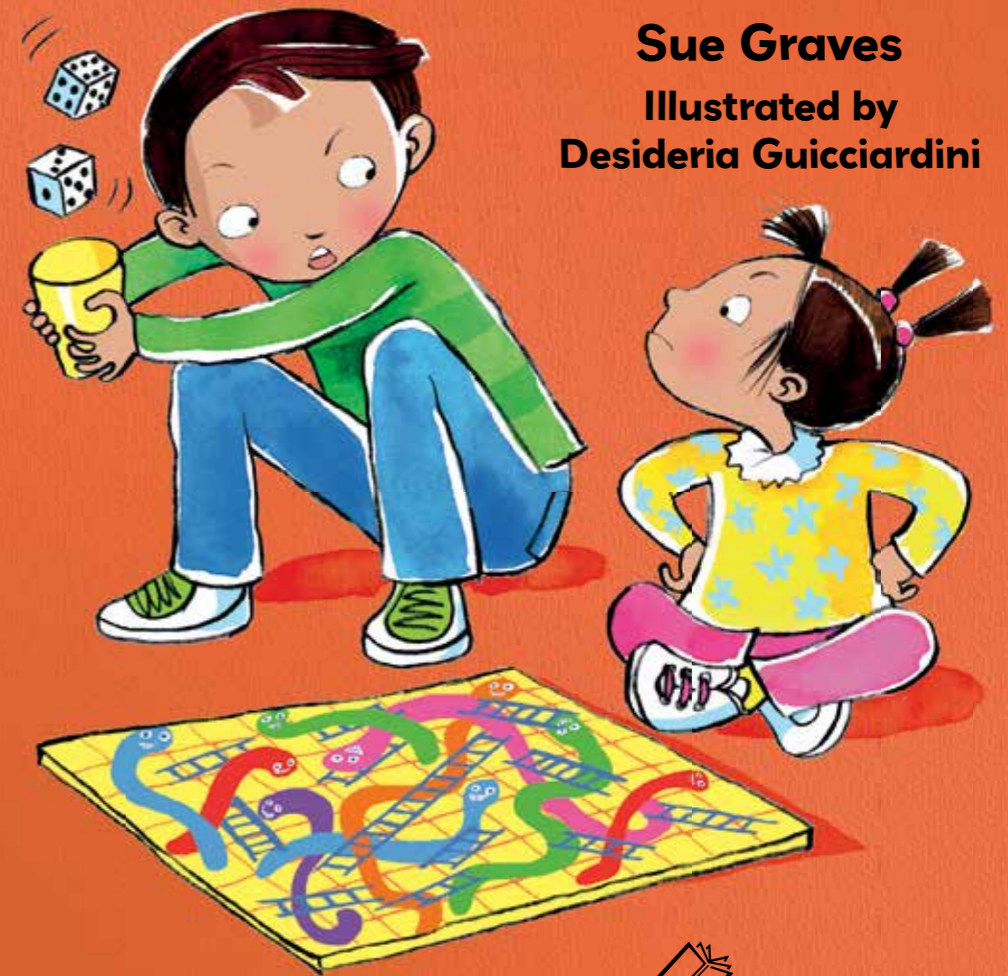

But Noah said rules were **silly!**



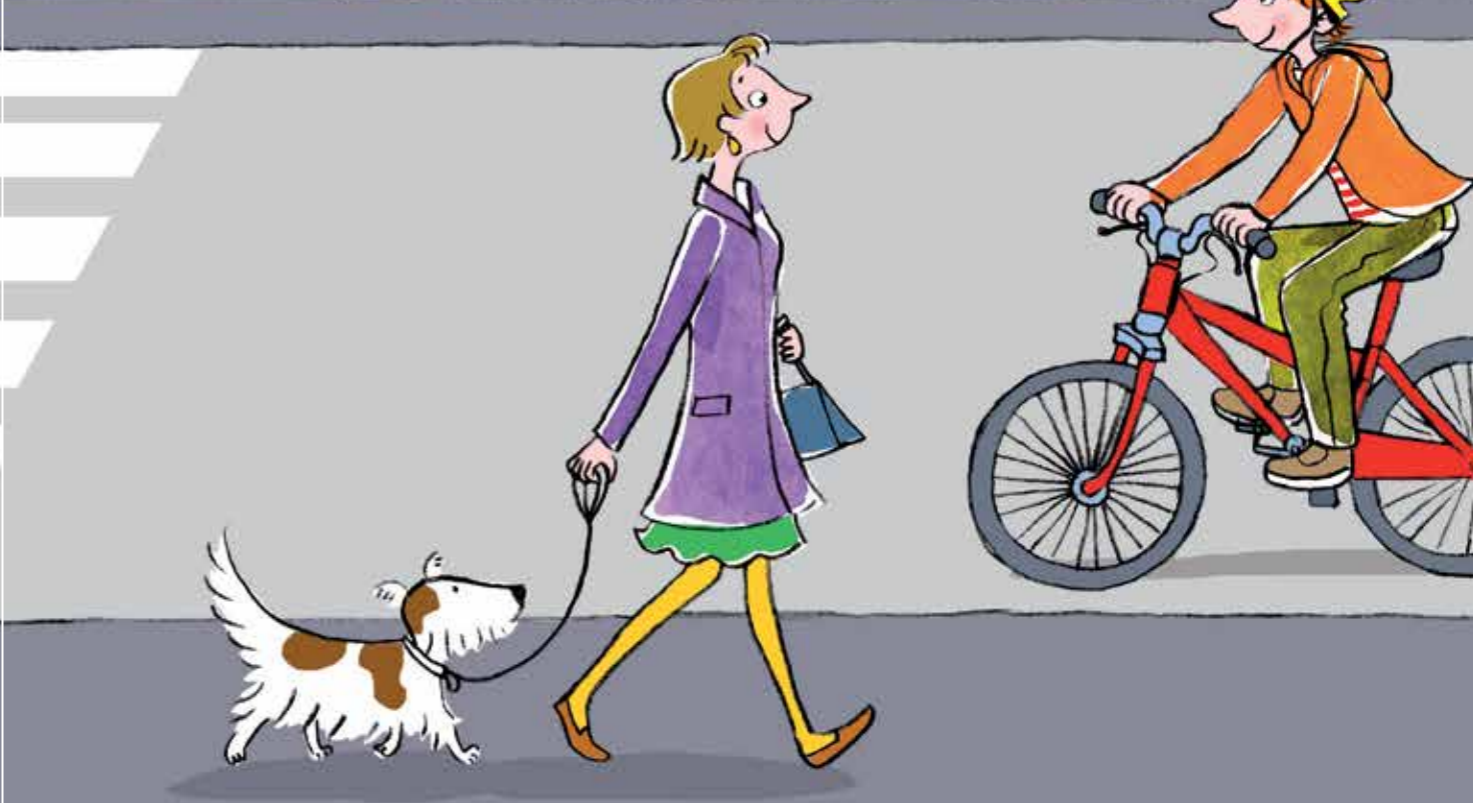
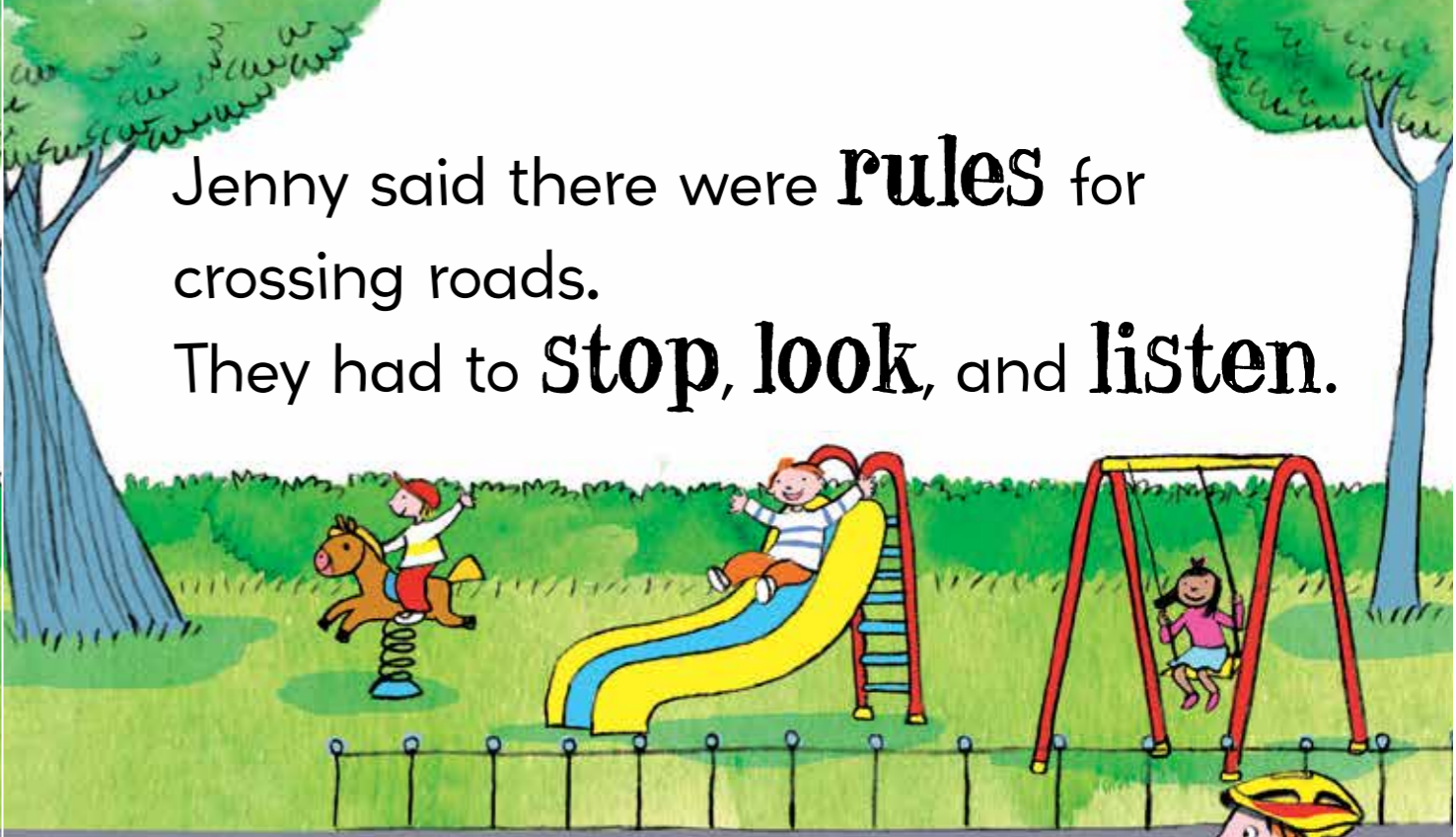
Jenny took them to the park.
